1 The above-entitled action came on for default judgment proceedings on June 19, 2007,  
2 before the Honorable Sue Kaplan, Judge Presiding in Department 218 of the San Francisco  
3 Superior Court. Plaintiffs Winifred W. Huang ("Ms. Huang") and Gregory D. Kovacic  
4 ("Mr. Kovacic") were represented by John Walker of Sonnenschein Nath & Rosenthal LLP.

5 Defendants Jay Rothstein, an individual, and China Venture Films, LLC, a California  
6 Limited Liability Company, were properly served with a copy of the summons and complaint as  
7 set forth in the Court's February 28, 2007 order. Each Defendant failed to answer the complaint  
8 or appear and defend the action within the time allowed by law. The clerk entered Defendant  
9 China Venture Films' default on November 22, 2006. The clerk entered Defendant Jay  
10 Rothstein's default on November 30, 2006.

11 The Defendants brought a motion for relief from default, which the Court denied on  
12 February 28, 2007. Defendant Jay Rothstein brought a second motion for relief from default,  
13 which the Court denied on April 2, 2007. Having defaulted, the Defendants made no appearance  
14 at the default judgment proceedings.

15 Prior to the hearing, Plaintiffs submitted the documents required by California Rule of  
16 Court 3.1800(a), including declarations from the Plaintiffs. The Court has reviewed and  
17 considered those documents.

18 **IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDICATED, AND DECREED THAT:**

19 1. Ms. Huang shall have and recover compensatory damages against Defendants Jay  
20 Rothstein and China Venture Films the sum of \$99,970, plus \$19,043.28 in prejudgment interest  
21 through June 19, 2007. Ms. Huang shall have and recover per diem interest of \$27.38 per day  
22 from June 20, 2007, until the Judgment is entered. Defendants are jointly and severally liable  
23 for these amounts.

24 2. Mr. Kovacic shall have and recover compensatory damages against Defendants Jay  
25 Rothstein and China Venture Films the sum of \$135,000, plus \$23,519.28 in prejudgment  
26 interest through June 19, 2007. Mr. Kovacic shall have and recover per diem interest of \$36.98  
27 per day from June 20, 2007, until the Judgment is entered. Defendants are jointly and severally  
28 liable for these amounts.

1           3. Ms. Huang shall have and recover attorneys' fees from Defendant Jay Rothstein in  
2 the sum of \$28,526.00. That sum shall bear post-judgment interest at the legal rate, currently  
3 10% per annum, from the date of their award until paid.

4           4. Ms. Huang is awarded costs of \$2,172.99. That sum shall bear post-judgment  
5 interest at the legal rate, currently 10% per annum, from the date of their award until paid.  
6 Defendants are jointly and severally liable for these amounts.

7           5. Mr. Kovacic is awarded costs of \$2,172.99. That sum shall bear post-judgment  
8 interest at the legal rate, currently 10% per annum, from the date of their award until paid.  
9 Defendants are jointly and severally liable for these amounts.

10          6. The Court retains jurisdiction to make such further orders as are necessary or  
11 proper to insure that the Judgment is effectively executed.

12          7. This Judgment shall be entered forthwith with notice of entry to the parties and to  
13 the Court.
